Final selection shall be conducted only for Delhi State school Games quarter finalist Team and quarter finalist of Delhi State Tournament. All the participants should be in their proper kit.

The player U-17 age category should be born on or after <u>01/01/2007</u> and U-19 age category should be born on or after <u>01/01/2005</u> and should be studying in 12th class or below but not below 6th Standard.teh participating player must be a regular enrolled student of the school.

The student/ player who has passed 12th standard will not be eligible to participate in the SGFI NSGs games irrespective of being in any age category.
