**CIRCULAR**

**Subject:- Final selection trial cum Coaching camp for 66<sup>th</sup> National School Games 2022-23 in Badminton (U-19 years) Boys & Girls from 25<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> May 2023 (Boys& Girls) from 10:30 AM onwards at Thyagraj Stadium, New Delhi.**

The Sports Branch, Directorate of Education, Govt. of NCT Delhi is going to conduct selection trial cum – coaching camp for Delhi School Students Badminton (U-19 years) Boys & Girls from 25<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> May 2023 (Boys& Girls) from 10:30 AM onwards at Thyagraj Stadium, New Delhi.

In this regard, reference is invited towards invitation letter dated 11/05/2023 and clarification of corrigendum letter dated 13/05/2023 issued by SGFI (copy enclosed).

The selected students/players will represent Delhi in 66<sup>th</sup> National School Games 2022-23 in Badminton (U-19 years) Boys & Girls Category w.e.f. 6<sup>th</sup> June 2023 to 12<sup>th</sup> June 2023 to be held at Gwalior (MP) under aegis of SGFI.

Trial will be only for Delhi State School Games (Top 8) (2022-23). All the participants should be in their proper kit.

The player should be born on or after 01/01/2004 and should be a student of up to 12<sup>th</sup> class or below but not below 8<sup>th</sup> Standard (The students who appeared for class XII exams during session New Delhi 2022-23 are also eligible.)

The students of Kendriya Vidyalaya are not eligible to participate in the selection trial.

**Following documents are mandatory to be provided on the date of trial:-**

1. The copy of birth certificate of the student, issued by the concerned Municipal Authority or the copy of Xth certificate mentioning Date of Birth issued by the concerned Board (CBSE/ICSE etc.) or the certificate from HOS/Principal of Govt. School/Recognized Private School mentioning Date of Birth of the student as per school record.

(In case of any age dispute the student may be subject to undergo medical examination for age verification from a Govt. Hospital).



2. Copy of Aadhar Card.
3. Copy of School – I Card last attended.

All students/players to bring all original documents like Birth Certificate, Xth Class certificate with DOB, Certificate of DOB from HOS/Principal, Aadhaar Card, School – I Card etc along with a photostat set (self attested).

The team manager will be responsible for bringing the eligibility/birth certificate of the participants, which are to be handed over to the organizing committee. In tournament only official entry form signed by the competent authority of State/UT/Unit will be acceptable. In the absense of duly signed official entry form it will not be possible to participate in the tournament & no merit/participation certificate will be issued.
