The Sports Branch, Directorate of Education, Govt. of NCT Delhi is going to conduct a coaching camp (U-14 Boys & Girls and U-17 Boys) w.e.f. 05th Dec 2023 to 25th Dec 2023 from 02:00 PM onwards at GGSSS Jhilmil Hockey Center Jhilmil Colony, Delhi-110095 and (U-19 Boys & Girls) w.e.f. 11th Dec 2023 to 04th Jan 2024 from 02:00 PM onwards at SBV Ashok Nagar Hockey Center Delhi, for the players of Hockey (U-14 Boys & Girls) of Delhi Schools, going to be selected through Delhi State School Games and (U-17 Boys and U-19 Boys & Girls) selected through Delhi State School Games (list enclosed).

The selected students/players will represent Delhi in 67th National School Games 2023-24 (U-14 Boys & Girls and U-17 Boys) w.e.f. 28th Dec 2023 to 01st Jan 2024 to be held at Gwalior (MP) and (U-19 Boys & Girls) w.e.f. 06th Jan 2024 to 11 Jan 2024 to be held at Jalandhar (Punjab) under the aegis of SGFI.

In this regard, reference is invited towards the invitation letter dated 17/11/2023 and 20/11/2023 issued by SGFI (copy enclosed).

The player of U-14 age category should be born on or after 01/01/2010, U-17 age category should be born on or after 01/01/2007 and U-19 age category should be born on or after 01/01/2005 and should be studying in 12th class or below but not below 6th Standard. The participating player must be a regular enrolled student of the school.

The student/ player who has passed 12th standard will not be eligible to participate in the SGFI NSGs games irrespective of being in any age category.

The students of Kendriya Vidyalaya are not eligible to participate in the selection trial.

Following documents are mandatory to be provided on the date of trial:-

1. The copy of birth certificate of the student, issued by the concerned Municipal Authority or the copy of Xth certificate mentioning Date of Birth issued by the concerned Board (CBSE/ICSE etc.) or the certificate from HOS/Principal of Govt. School/Recognized Private School mentioning Date of Birth of the student as per school record.

(In case of any age dispute the student may be subject to undergo medical examination for age verification from a Govt. Hospital).

2. Copy of Aadhar Card.
3. Copy of School – I Card last attended

All students/players to bring all original documents like Birth Certificate, Xth Class certificate with DOB, Certificate of DOB from HOS/Principal, Aadhaar Card, School – I Card etc along with a photostat set (self attested).

- Any student / Player who has passed 12th standard will not be eligible to participate in the SGFI 1999 games irrespective of being in any age category.
