A. BACKGROUND:

Performance Grading Index is a tool designed by Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education, Government of India to:

Dated: 31 05/2021

- i. Provide insights on the status of school education in States/ UTs & Districts, including key levers that drive their performance and critical areas of performance.
- ii. Catalyze transformational change in the field of school education.
- iii. Propel States/UTs & Districts towards undertaking multi-pronged interventions that will bring about the muchdesired optimal education outcomes.
- iv. Help States/UTs & Districts to pinpoint the gaps and accordingly prioritize areas for intervention to ensure that the school education system is robust at every level.
- 2. The State/UT level Performance Grading was done for the year 2017-18,2018-19 and 2019-20.
- 3. However, a need was felt to assess the performance at District level to
 - a) Ensure uniform progress in each district across various parameters.
 - b) Focus on districts which require additional support to help them perform better.
 - c) Provide equitable and quality education to all children across districts.
- 4. Therefore, to monitor and assess the performance at District level, District PGI has been designed by DoSEL, MoE this year.
 - B. Structure of Performance Grading Index(PGI):
 - i. The Performance Grading Index has the following structure:

A PGI District Application has been created on the Shagun portal of Ministry of Education, GoI on similar lines as the State/UT PGI application. All entries are to be made on it.

F. INTRUCTIONS FOR NODAL OFFICERS:

- The Nodal Officers are entrusted with the responsibility of collection, compilation and verification of data of their respective Districts with respect to Indicators & Subindicators as per Annexure 1(District Level). It may please be noted that
 - a) Data is to be collected in respect of
 - i. DoE schools
 - ii. DoE Aided Schools
 - iii. DMC schools
 - iv. DMC Aided schools
 - v. NDMC schools
 - vi. NDMC Aided schools
 - vii. DCB schools
 - viii. DSW schools
 - b) Information ONLY in respect of Indicators & Sub-Indicators as given in Annexure
 1(District Level) is to be collected & compiled.
 - c) A format has been devised to collect the data from school level which is placed at
 Annexure 2(School Level)
 - d) For the remaining Indicators, the data will be fetched directly from UDISE+ 2019-20.
 - e) The Reference Year for the data is 2019-20, except for the Indicators from 1.1.1 to 1.1.12 for which the Reference Year is 2017-18.
 - f) The Nodal Officers-DPGI shall share the compiled data of their respective Districts with the MIS-Coordinators-DPGI by 10th June, 2021.

G. INSTRUCTIONS FOR MIS COORDINATORS:

- A Login ID for MIS-Coordinator in respect of each District has been created. The Login ID & Password for the same will be shared on their individual mail lds.
- 2. The MIS-Coordinators-DPGI shall enter the data received from Nodal Officers on Shagun portal using the following pathway
 - a) http://pgi.seshagun.gov.in/shagun/
 - b) Login using your Login & password as received in your personal Mail ID
 - c) In the Menu bar on the left, click on District PGI
 - d) Enter data in each indicator
 - e) After checking the entries, click 'Submit'
 - f) Take a printout.
 - g) This process should be completed by 15 June, 2021.

H. State-PGI Committee shall

- a) Create/view/edit or delete the District MIS user credentials.
- b) Scrutinize the data submitted by each district.
- c) In case of any errors, the State PGI shall delete the entry and direct the concerned district to renter the correct data.
- d) After all the entries are found correct, State-PGI Committee shall finally submit the data on DPGI portal, after seeking approval of President-EC,Samagra Shiksha.
- e) The entries done by MIS Coordinators in District PGI portal will be approved at State Level by validating it, based on the values against the indicators.
