CIRCULAR

Subject:- Celebrating Rangotsav in Schools under Sub-Component Funds for Quality (LEP, Innovation, Guidance etc.) of Major Component Quality Interventions of Delhi under Samagra Shiksha 2020-21

The Project Approval Board, Ministry of Education, Govt of India has approved Rangotsav, the festival of colours which will be conducted online at elementary level in Govt. schools of DoE, MCDs, DCB and NDMC Delhi.

1. On account of closure of schools due to the pandemic, the activities will be conducted online at school level, as well as at cluster level in the first week of January, 2021.
2. Target group and proposed activities at various level in school-

3. DURCC's will search and collect guidance videos links pertaining to activities mentioned above, from different sites and share them with schools, which will help teachers to train and acquaint students with the activities. These videos must be shared at least two weeks before the Rangotsav activities.

4. There will be 3 activities at each level. Every student must participate at least in one of the activities and submit their entries on A-4 sheets by 04.01.2021.
5. Teachers will conduct the online activities at school level through whatsapp and other online modes. They will instruct students and parents regarding the activities and ways to submit the entries online clearly indicating name, class and section of each child.
6. The best 3 entries for each activity will be selected by the school judgement team which comprises of (HoS/In-charge Teacher/SMC member. These selected entries will be sent in hard as well as soft copy to the concerned CRCC for evaluation at cluster level.
7. Judgement team at cluster level will comprise of 1 CRCC, 2 HoS (1 of DoE and 1 of MCD). The team will select the best 3 entries of each activity (3 activities) from each level (3 levels) at cluster level i.e., total of 9 prizes (I, II, III prize) will be distributed to the winners by 30.01.2021.
