**CIRCULAR**

The annual observance of International Day of Persons with Disabilities (IDPD) is on **3<sup>rd</sup> December 2022**. The observance of the Day aims to promote an understanding of disability issues and mobilize support for the dignity, rights and well-being of persons with disabilities. It also seeks to increase awareness of gains to be derived from the integration of persons with disabilities in every aspect of political, social, economic and cultural life. The theme for the IDPD 2022 is ***"Transformative solutions for inclusive development: the role of innovation in fuelling an accessible and equitable world."***

In this regard, all HOS of the Govt., Govt. Aided, MCD, NDMC, DCB & MCD Aided, and NDMC Aided Schools are directed to organize competitions like Drawing/Painting, Slogan Writing, Singing/Poem Recitation, Solo/Group Dance, Skit/Group Play and Sports Activities amongst Children with Disabilities (CWSN/CWD) & peers. The activities shall be organized separately for Class Pre-School to V, Class VI to VIII, & Class IX to XII.

**Instructions:**

1. The theme for the IDPD 2022 is *"Transformative solutions for inclusive development: the role of innovation in fuelling an accessible and equitable world"*. It focuses on recovering from pandemic and creating a disability-inclusive and sustainable society where persons with disabilities can enjoy equal access.
2. Competitions shall be held separately for each item at separate levels.
3. All the entries pertaining to the above mentioned activities shall be prepared by the CWSN/CWD at school by **9<sup>th</sup> December 2022**. Special Education Teachers (SETs) shall ensure that entries are prepared by the CWSN/CWD himself/herself and they shall only provide necessary guidance & assistance.
4. PGT/TGT (Special Education Teachers)/Resource Persons (CWSN/CWD)/Special Educators in case of MCD Schools/Teacher in-charges shall provide necessary support to CWSN/CWD.
5. Drawing sheets shall be provided to CWSN/CWD who wishes to participate in drawing/painting and/or slogan writing by HOS at least 02 days in advance.
6. The prepared entries shall be submitted by concerned Resource Person (CWSN/CWD)/Special Educator in case of MCD Schools/Teacher in-charge in the concerned district's IE Cell **latest by 9<sup>th</sup> December 2022**.
7. HOS shall constitute a committee of PGT/TGT (SET)/Resource Person (CWSN/CWD)/Special Educator in case of MCD Schools/Teacher in-charge, Drawing Teacher, PET & Music Teacher at school level and evaluate the entries.
8. One best entry from each activity across each category along with the Name of Student, Student ID, Class & Section, School Name & ID, Type of Disability, and Percentage of Disability shall be submitted to the concerned District Coordinator (IE), DoE for further consideration in respect of district & state level program to be held in the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> week of December 2022 respectively. A detailed report with regard to the organization of these competitions shall also be submitted along.

9. The detailed guidelines for the district level celebration of International Day of Persons with Disabilities (IDPD) shall be issued shortly.
10. HOS shall ensure that all CWSN/CWD enrolled in the school shall participate in at least one of the competitions.

In addition to above, HOS shall ensure that all subject teachers who are taking classes for children with or without disabilities conduct five minute classroom discussion about the significance of the IDPD.

This issues with the prior approval of the competent authority.
