CIRCULAR

Subject: Online entry on e-district portal of beneficiaries under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Pre-matric Scholarship for SC students" for the year 2021-22 for Delhi Govt./Govt. Aided/Recognized Unaided Private Schools.

All HoSs are informed that the Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Pre-matric Scholarship for SC students" has been launched for 2021-22 on e-district portal of Govt. of NCT of Delhi by the Deptt for Welfare of SC/ST/OBC, GNCTD on 20.09.2021. In this regard, the letter No. F.11(243)/Such/DSCST/Bulk data/20110-21/7448-51 dated 16.09.2021 is attached herewith (Annexure 'A'). Accordingly, all HoSs are hereby directed to make aware/encourage the eligible students to apply under the scheme "Pre-matric Scholarship for SC students" for the year 2021-22 on e-district portal directly and to help eligible students belonging to deprived class, in filling online requests on e-district portal. All HoSs must ensure displaying of information on Notice Board regarding launching of said scheme and setting up of a Help Desk in school and nominating a Nodal Officer to assist the eligible students to apply online.

In case of minor, the registration of parent is required. The parents, who are already registered on e-district portal, do not require re-registration because they already have login credential to access e-district portal. The steps of procedure for the parents, who are not yet registered on e-district portal, are given at Annexure- 'B'.

Now, by using login credential and selecting Apply Section and choosing concerned scheme of the Department for welfare of SC/ST scheme, then select specific scheme out of 4 schemes, namely "Post/Pre-Matric scholarship for SC/OBC students. The application will be opened. In this application form the detail of applicant student will be filled up to avail benefit of scholarship scheme.

The following points may be noted and complied with for smooth and effective implementation of the scheme:

- 1. Students currently studying in class IX to X in Delhi Govt./Govt. Aided/Recognized Unaided Private Schools are eligible for the scheme.
- Students should belong to Scheduled Caste (SC) category.
- 3. SC caste certificate in the name of the student/father should be issued by the S.D.M./Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
- 4. Domicile certificate of Delhi if the caste certificate is not issued by the competent authority of Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
- Students, whose parents/guardians income from all sources do not exceed Rs. 2.5 Lakh per annum.
- 6. An Income declaration by the self-employed parents/guardians, stating definite income from all sources by way of an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper.
- Failed/Repeater students are not eligible.
- 8. The student obtaining benefits under this scheme shall not be allowed to avail benefits under any other centrally sponsored/State scholarship scheme
- 9. Students shall be encouraged to have Aadhaar seeded bank accounts to facilitate payments through the Aadhaar Payment Bridge System. Aadhaar seeded bank account should be in the name of the students. HoSs/Nodal Officers are advised to check whether bank accounts of the students are seeded with their Aadhaar.
- All the documents/records shall be maintained/kept at school level.
- 11. The rate of scholarship will be Rs. 225/- per month for 10 months plus Rs. 750/- as Books and Ad-hoc grants for the students of class IX and X.



Revised procedure for filing online application on e-district portal Schools in Delhi under various Central Sponsored Scholarship Schemes for the year 2021-22.

Madam/Sir.

- Department for the Welfare of SC/ST/OBC is the Nodal Department to administer various kind of Scholarship Scheme belonging to the students of SC/ST/OBC categories. The following Central Sponsored Schemes are administered by the Department:
 - 1. Post Matric Scholarship for SC students
 - 2. Pre-Matric Scholarship for SC students
 - 3. Post Matric Scholarship for OBC students
 - 4. Pre-Matric Scholarship for OBC students
- As per existing procedure, the Students who reside in Delhi and belonging to SC & OBC category are presently required to apply online for the above Central Sponsored Scholarship Schemes through e-district portal. The applications of the SC & OI3C Students studying in other than Government/Government Aided Schools/institutions are being verified and forward by the School/Institution concerned to the Administrative Department concerned.

- 3. The Administrative Department (Directorate of Education/Higher Education/Technical Education, as the case may be) after taking appropriate decision on the application (either to approve or reject the application) forward the same to this department for making sanction and disbursal of Scholarship to the beneficiary through Aadhaar Seeded bank account.
- 4. In regard to the students belonging to SC & OBC category, studying in Government/Government aided schools, as per the present procedure, the Administrative Department concerned uploads and approves the bulk data of beneficiaries on PFMS portal using their dedicated login credentials. The DSCST department downloads the excel file of bulk data and process for sanction through e-payment under DBT mode, on the portal. Thereafter the amount of scholarship is credited to Aadhaar seeded bank account of beneficiaries.
- 5. Now, the Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment has changed the above procedure of disposal of application and released new guidelines for Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for SC students, the same is also available on the official Website of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (https://socialjustice.nic.in).
- 6. As per the revised guidelines issued by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. Of India, it has been decided to amend the present procedure of disbursal of scholarship amount to SC & OBC students w.e.f the current financial year 2021-22.
- Pre-matric scholarship schemes are for the SC & OBC students studying in class IX & class X and the Post-matric scholarship schemes for the SC & OBC students studying in class XI & class XII. The eligible Students of SC & OBC category either studying in Government/Govt. aided schools or studying in non-Government/ private recognized schools will apply on e-district portal directly. The Schools/institutions will identify the eligible SC & OBC students of their Schools and encourage them to apply for these Scholarships. Further, it is also advised to help their students belonging to deprived class, in filing online requests on e-district portal.

- As per the revised guidelines, the scholarship funding pattern will be on 60:40 sharing ratio between the Centre and State. On receiving the online applications of the SC & OBC Students, the same will be verified by the School/Institution concerned and forwarded to the Administrative Department concerned. The Administrative Department (Zonal authority of Directorate of Education) after taking appropriate decision on the applications will forward the same to this department for making payment of 40% of the total amount of Scholarship to the beneficiary through Aadhaar Seeded bank account. The Department for the Welfare of SC/ST/OBC after releasing the share of 40% of scholarship amount will upload the data to the National Scholarship Portal of Central Government to release the balance i.e. 60% of the scholarship directly to the beneficiary. Accordingly, the procedure of uploading and approving the bulk data has now been discontinued from the current financial year in respect of the schemes at Para 1, as this department will transfer the data to National Scholarship Portal of Central Government for making payment of rest 60% of the scholarship amount.
- 9. A scholarship holder under this scheme shall not be eligible for any other scholarship/stipend. If awarded any other scholarship/stipend, the student can exercise his/her option for either of the two scholarships/stipend, whichever is more beneficial to him/her, and should inform the awarding authority through the Head of institution about the option made. No scholarship will be paid to the students under this scheme from the date he/she accepts another scholarship/stipend.
- 10. The institutions under your control are advised to take the following measures to spread awareness among students and parents:
 - (i) Students shall be encouraged To have Aadhaar seeded Bank accounts to facilitate payments through the Aadhaar Payment Bridge.
 - (ii) Setting up a help desl: by the Educational Institutes and appoint a Nodal Officer to assist the eligible students to apply online.
 - (iii) Information may be prominently displayed on the notice boards of Educational Institutes.
 - (iv) Students should be briefed about the scholarship schemes and their benefits, regularly, during the online classes by wattsup, telephonically and verbally.
