CIRCULAR

In continuation to the Circular No.F.88/DDE(IEDSS)/Admn.Cell/2016/289-300 dated 02/05/2022 wherein instructions were laid down for screening and identification of CWD/CWSN studying in the schools of Directorate of Education, GNCT Delhi for the session 2022-23.

All concerned are hereby informed that the master-training scheduled to be imparted by NCERT to 30 PGT/TGT- Special Education Teachers with respect to the screening tool developed by NCERT titled, 'Special Attention to Special Needs: Screening tool for School Students' for universal screening of CWD/CWSN is withheld for the time being. The Department shall further update regarding the same as and when the schedule is finalized.

In this regard, all HOS of Govt. schools of DoE, DoE Aided, & Schools of Local Bodies (MCD, MCD Aided, NDMC, NDMC Aided, and DCB management) are directed to ensure the yearly screening of students for identification of any disabilities present. The screening and identification process shall be conducted by Special Education Teachers (PGT & TGT)/Special Educator/RP (CWSN)/Teacher-In-charge under the supervision of concerned HOS by following below given instructions:

1. Screening of 21 disabilities as given in the *Schedule* of the RPWD Act, 2016 to be done.
2. Only the name of those children with disabilities should be included, whose valid Disability Certificate/UDID card issued by Competent Authority is available or whose valid assessment report stating the type of disability prepared by a professional registered with Rehabilitation Council of India or Medical Council of India or concerned State Council is available. In case of students who do not have disability certificate, schools shall ensure the availability of disability certificate/UDID with the help of parents from the designated hospital.
3. Students under Mission Buniyad i.e. Beginner, Character & Word-level in Hindi/Urdu and Beginner & Digit identification (upto 99) in Mathematics must be screened by PGT/TGT-SET/Special Educator/RP (CWSN)/Teacher-In-charge concerned in collaboration with class & subject teacher. The screening report of these children shall be maintained

separately and only after detailed assessment/diagnosis & further confirmation they will be included in the CWD/CWSN list.

4. The detailed assessment/diagnosis for such identified students under Mission Buniyad shall be conducted at the District Resource Centre or Assessment Camp held at district/zone level.
5. The school-level screening/identification of CWD/CWSN shall be completed latest by 08/08/2022. District Coordinators (IE) shall compile the data of Govt. schools of DoE, DoE Aided, & Schools of Local Bodies (MCD, MCD Aided, NDMC, NDMC Aided, and DCB management) and submit to Inclusive Education Branch, Lajpat Nagar –IV latest by 12.08.2022 in the format given in **Annexure- I**.
6. Schools shall ensure that the compiled data of students with disabilities is always available with them and Special Education Teacher (TGT & PGT)/ Special Educator/In-charge concerned.
7. **Schools shall also ensure that the details of children identified as having disability are updated in the Student Module under 'existing students' link. Schools shall also ensure that NO school is sending the data directly to Inclusive Education Branch.**
