4. Modalities of Implementation:

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One day offline quiz will be organized entirely in the respective classroom in Govt. schools of Delhi every month. It intends to inculcate the sense of calculation to promote mass participation. These wizards are stimulated in learning environments around Maths that allow students to enhance their learning level. Rubrics will be developed to select the students. Best performer will be awarded which will further motivate other students to perform well.

By combining maths and spelling, the event activity can be made more diverse and appealing to a wider range of participants while promoting both language and maths skills.

Maths Wizard and Spell Genius will:

- a) Supplement the existing Math curriculum and make learning Mathematics an enjoyable experience.
- b) Encourage students to think critically and creatively.
- c) Participate in Math related activities.
- d) Improve Math proficiency- understanding of Math concepts and improve Math skills.
- e) Fostering a love for math.

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- f) To make students learn about Math's skills.
- g) To arise interest among the students to beat the monotonous classroom situations.
- h) To provide exposure in the field of maths to attend math's Olympiads without any fear.
- i) To enable children to become motivated and engaged in Mathematics and Technology (MT) through observation, experimentation, drawing inferences, model building, rational reasoning, and testability.
 - j) To create curiosity, excitement, and exploration among school children in Science, Mathematics and Technology.
 - K) To create a culture of thinking, inventing, and doing; to promote enquiry-based learning in schools.
 - To achieve learning levels appropriate to the class of study in Mathematics.
 - m) To encourage and nurture schools to be incubators of Innovation

Activities:

a) Setting up of Maths club: Establish a Maths Club where students with a passion for Mathematics can meet, collaborate on Maths projects and participate in maths related activities.

b) Arranging Monthly Math Quiz

- c) Maths Art Competition: Combine Maths with creativity. Ask students to create art work that incorporates mathematical concept and then the judges/teachers evaluate their work.
- d) Puzzle and Games: Setup stations with various maths puzzles and games such as Sudoku, Rubik's cubes for students to enjoy. Create word puzzles where participants must solve maths problem to reveal the letter that form a word.
- e) Poster presentation: Students to prepare informative posters explaining mathematical concepts or famous mathematicians. Students can improve their vocabulary, spellings and pronunciation as well.
- f) Collaborative projects: Assign group projects where students must apply maths to real life problems and present their findings. A team based activities can be organised where one member might be responsible for maths challenge while another spells the words.
