CIRCULAR

Subject: Celebrating Rangotsav in Schools (DoE, MCD, NDMC and DCB) under Experiential Learning at Elementary Level (Grades I to VIIIth) under Samagra Shiksha for year 2023-24.

Rangotsav, a festival of colours is an annual activity conducted under the aegis of Samagra Shiksha-Delhi to promote experiential and joyful learning through various cultural activities.

This year too, the festival of colours, Rangotsav has been approved by Project Approval Board (PAB 2023-24) of Ministry of Education, Govt. of India. The activities will be done at Elementary level in Govt. Schools on the theme - "MY INDIA, MY PRIDE" which resonates India's achievements, legacy of freedom fighters, how india can become self-reliant etc.

Target group and proposed activities at various level in school-

Class - II	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tri Color Painting (Thumb painting/Leaf Printing/ any other innovative method as the teacher may decide)
Class - III	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Drawing & Coloring (Topic- Self Reliant India / आत्म निर्भर भारत)
Class - IV	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Collage making (Topic- Incredible India/अतुल्य भारत)
Class - V	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Best Out of Waste Craft Competition - Swachh Bharat-Reuse of waste Material/Resource Conservation
Class-VI	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Patriotic song/Dance competition
Class -VII	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Poster Making Competition(Topic- Self Reliant India आत्म निर्भर भारत)
Class -VIII	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Traditional Folk Art Painting Competition(अतुल्य भारत/Incredible India)

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Guidelines for conduct Festival of "Rangotsav":-

1. The activities are to be conducted at school level i.e. For Classes I to VIII (wherever post primary classes are not there till primary level).
2. Encourage every student to participate in the activity and submit their entries in the following form:-

- **Fancy Dress Competition Theme Freedom Fighters (Class I)-** Children can dress-up any of their favourite freedom fighters and speak 3-4 lines about their character/slogan.
- **Tri Colour Painting (Thumb Painting/Leaf Printing) (Class II)-** With an aim to inculcate respect for the country and its diversity in the young minds students can make any thumb/Leaf printing by using Tri Colours (saffron, white and green) on a drawing sheet or any other pastel sheets.
- **Drawing & Colouring (Topic- Self Reliant India/आत्मनिर्भर भारत) (Class III)-** Students can produce their own artwork based on the given theme on an A4 size sheet. Judgement criteria for this competition will be based on the overall presentation & idea.
- **Collage Making (Topic- अतुल्य भारत/Incredible India (Class IV) -** A variety of collage techniques helps to enhance exploratory mind and imagination. Student will make a collage on A3 size sheet and showcase their creativity on any topic such as - Millets, Indian Culture, and Famous Places in India, etc.
- **Best Out of Waste Competition Theme-Topic Swatch Bharat-Reuse of waste Material/Resource Conservation (Class V)-** Student enhances his/her imagination and creativity by doing innovative things using reusable and recyclable materials such as newspapers, shoe boxes, bangles, ice-cream sticks and more.
- **Patriotic Song/Dance Competition (Class VI)-** The student may choose a song of 3-4 minutes duration so as to showcase his/her hidden talent. The entries will be judged on the basis of rhythm, composition, coordination and overall impression.
- **Poster making competition (Topic- Self Reliant India/आत्मनिर्भर भारत) (Class VII) -** Student will make poster on A3, Legal size or a poster size.
- **Traditional Folk/ Art Paintings- Theme--Incredible India- अतुल्य भारत (Class VIII) -** The inspiration and power of art play a vital role in enabling our children to enhance their creative talent and develop their artistic skills. Students can choose any one traditional folk art like-

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Madhubani, Kalamkari, Warli Art, etc. and would depict it on an A3 size sheet.

3. Teachers will inform parents and guide them and students to explore their creativity and the ways to submit the entries clearly indicating name, class and section of each child.
4. Best entry for each grade will be selected by the School Judgement Team Including Principal/In-charge Teacher and concerned CRCC for evaluation.
