

Subject- Programme Evaluation Study of the Vidya Pravesh (School Readiness) Programme by Ministry of Education, Govt. of India

Vidya Pravesh- A Three Month's Play Based School Preparation Module for Grade I has been developed as per the recommendations of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 by NCERT and is implementation in Delhi began from academic year April 2022 with nomenclature VIDYARAMBH.

This Three Month's Play based learning module consists of a 12 Week Programme for Grade 1 designed to bridge the gap in the readiness of children for School. It encompasses developmentally appropriate teaching learning strategies to booster a child's pre-literacy, pre-numeracy, cognitive and social skills.

Ministry of Education, Govt. of India with NCERT will be conducting a Evaluation Study of this programme which will start very soon in the selected districts of Delhi as per the attached list.

The HoS of the Schools Mentioned in the attached list are expected to cooperate with the Field Investigators visiting schools to collect data. The process will include conducting interviews with Teachers, Parents and Students. The duration of data collection in one school will be two days. The Field Investigators will interview School Heads and Teachers and will conduct school observation as well as class-room observation and Focus Group Discussions.

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Programme Evaluation of Vidya Pravesh

(Guidelines)

Programme evaluation of implementation of Vidya Pravesh (a 3-month play based school preparation module for children entering Grade I) in six states and UTs.

I. About Vidya Pravesh

Vidya Pravesh— Three-month Play-based School Preparation Module for Grade-I has been developed as per the recommendations of the National Education Policy (NEP 2020). The intent is to ensure that all children are exposed to a warm and welcoming environment when they enter Grade-I leading to their smooth transition to school. The module consists of detailed guidelines for teachers on the rationale of the programme, pedagogical perspectives, assessment, etc. It also includes exemplified activities and worksheets to be introduced in the initial three months or 12 weeks of Grade-I. The activities are designed to help children develop different competencies like helping, sharing, getting along with other children, following a school routine, learning to adjust to a new environment and concentrating on an activity for a period of time to increase their attention span.

This programme is being implemented by the State/UT with similar or different names e.g., School readiness programme, Balvatika, etc. To understand the implementation of the same, it is necessary to collect, analyse and identify the differences and similarities in State-designed documents with the various components of Vidya Pravesh, viz., curriculum, manuals, assessments, training materials (print and non-print), training programmes, monitoring, etc. The materials developed by the State/UT may include guidelines, modules, videos, flyers, workbooks, activity books, etc.

This study will be conducted on 270 schools (45 schools per selected state/UT).

II. Objectives of the study:

• To document differences and similarities in State-design of various components of Vidya Pravesh, curriculum, manuals, assessments, training, monitoring, alignment with Grade 1, etc.

- To document implementation challenges and best practices across six states and UTs
- To evaluate comprehensiveness of Implementation Plan developed by the states and UTs.
- To identify Systemic and School level enables/inhibitors in the implementation of Vidya Pravesh
- To evaluate short term impact on school –preparedness outcomes of students entering Grade 1 from diverse socio-economic backgrounds and from diverse systems functional for education of children from 3-6 years.

III. Tools developed for the study:

Following nine tools have been developed for this study-

- 1. Document Analysis Tool (DAT)
- 2. Interview Schedule for State Functionaries (ISSF)
- 3. Performa for Focus Group Discussion (FGD) with Academic Task Force (PFGDATFP)
- 4. Interview Schedule for School Heads (ISSH)
- 5. Interview Schedule for Teachers teaching in class 1(IST)
- 6. Performa for FGD with Parents (PFGDP)
- 7. School Observation Schedule (SOS)
- 8. Classroom Observation Schedule (COS)
- 9. Learners School Preparation Assessment Tool (LSPAT)

Each of the above tools contains detailed instructions and guidelines for Field Investigators about the implementation of the tools.

All the tools have been pilot tested in 6 school covering three states- Delhi, Odisha and Rajasthan.


The FIs are expected to implement Tool No. 4-9 in the schools. Therefore, a set of these six tools along with shapes and story-cards will be provided to all the FIs.

IV. Overall Organizational Structure for the Study

The organisational structure of Study includes constitution of Committees, Teams, and Groups. For this study, advisory committee including Secretary, Joint Secretary of MoE and Director, NCERT has been constituted to provide guidance and advise to the whole process of this study. Then, a Study-Team has been constituted including Faculty members from NCERT, MoE and UNICEF. The Study -Team will be responsible for the actual conduct of the study, collection and analysis of data and

preparing state-wise and a compiled report. The details including roles and responsibilities are given below:


Overall Organisational Structure








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Role- To plan and execute the programme evaluation in selected six states and UTs.







FIELD INVESTIGATING TEAM (15 Teams per State/UT, each team will have two members, Role – Data collection and Data Analysis

V. Role of Field Investigator:

- 1. A Field Investigator in this study is either a member of the notified study team or a member of special invitees' group (NIE/RIE, NCERT) or from Consultant Group of NCERT/MoE or from UNICEF or a faculty member of SCERT/DIET or a JPF/student nominated by RIE/SCERT/DIET
- 2. Two field investigators, one Principal Field Investigator and one Field Investigator will form one Field Investigator Team (FIT).
- 3. Principal Field Investigator will be either a member of the notified study team or a member of special invitees' group (NIE/RIE, NCERT) or from Consultant Group of NCERT/MoE or from UNICEF or a faculty member of SCERT/DIET
- 4. The Field Investigators will be given thorough orientation on the tools by the Coordinators of the Study -Team and Study Groups..
- 5. A team of 2 Field Investigators (One PFI and one FI) will visit 3 schools assigned to them under the sampling process.
- 6. The duration of the data collection in one school will be two days. On the first day of the visit, FIs will interview School heads and teachers and will conduct school observation as well as the classroom observation and FGD with parents. On the first day itself they will go to the classroom of grade 1 to make rapport with the teachers. They need to seek help from the teacher to get introduced to the children from class so that they can conduct the LSPAT. The LSPAT will be conducted on the second day of the visit.
- 7. Instructions related to different tools have been included within each tool.
- 8. While collecting data from the schools, this need to be kept in mind that if single teacher is handling all the classes in the school, then FIs need to be empathetic with the teacher and accordingly make plan to implement the tool taking care of time available to teacher, while also helping teachers in the management of classes.
- 9. Following points need to be kept in view in the implementation of these tools-

(i) Field Investigator need to be very cordial with school heads, teachers, parents, and children. They need to first clarify the purpose of study to

all from whom they are collecting data in the manner they feel is appropriate as per the contexts. It must be clarified that the purpose of the study is not to assess learning of children or competence of teachers, the purpose is to evaluation system's preparation and proficiency for the implementation of Vidya Pravesh. (ii) Field Investigator needs to spark in the language which school heads, teachers and parents understand. In case learners speak a language different from that of the Field Investigators, they need to get help from the class teacher of Grade 1 in the concerned school for LSPAT.

(iii) All field investigators need to go through objectives, content, and guidelines of the Vidya Pravesh module. After collecting all the data, field investigators will make a brief report on the data collection process including challenges/issues they faced and limitations in the collection of data and submit this report to the State-study Group (SSG) along with all the filled-Performa including their contact details.

(iv) Since it is a programme evaluation, the same FIs will visit the same schools after a 3-month period. So, they need to block their dates after their first visit for the second visit.

VI. Role of Coordinators of State- Study Groups

1. Coordinators of the State-Study Group is in most of the cases are the State Coordinator from RIE, NCERT and faculty members from NIE. They will coordinate with nodal officer of the state (Samagra Shiksha and SCERT) and finalise all the State-study Groups and Field Investigating Teams as per the Table in Annexure I. They will inform everyone in the team to attend meetings and capacity building programmes as when these will be announced by the Study-Team and State Study Group. They will coordinate with all the PFIs and FIs for the study.

2. They will look after the expenditures, etc. required for the study as per the NCERT norms and practices at the RIEs.

3. They will ask all the FIs to submit all the filled-in formats to Coordinators. These will be later analysed constituting a team.

4. Coordinators will prepare state-report involving some more PFIs in their team after data analysis.

5. For data analysis and preparation of report, an orientation programme will be organised by the Study-Team.

VII. Role of Nodal Officer from Samagra Shiksha -

In this study, role of Nodal Officer(s) from Samagra Shiksha nominated by the MoE is as follows:

1. They will help in finalising the sampled schools based on the criteria already given in this guideline under sampling of schools.

2. They will facilitate the logistics of field visits with coordinators of the studygroups.

3. They are expected to provide copies of material developed at the state level either adopting or adapting Vidya Pravesh and the related circulars and notifications.

4. They also represents the Academic Task Force (ATF), so they will also provide data on the role of ATF in the implementation of Vidya Parvesh.

VIII. Role of Nodal Officer from SCERTs or Director, SCERT

In this study, role of Nodal Officer(s) from SCERT nominated by the MoE is as follows:

1. They are expected to nominate Field Investigators – faculty members/students from SCERTs and DIETs. They will work with the coordinators of the Study-Group for making FIT- with two FIs.

2. They provide copies of material developed at the state level either adopting or adapting Vidya Pravesh and the related circulars and notifications.

3. They also represents the Academic Task Force (ATF), so they will also provide data on the role of ATF in the implementation of Vidya Parvesh.

IX. Identified Schools for Sampling

List of 45 sampled schools in the six selected states/UTs for this programme evaluation has been shared with all the Coordinators of State-study Groups. All the Coordinators need to follow the following guidelines provided by UNICEF for finalising the sampled schools for the visit with the concerned states or UT-

1. The U-DISE+ code of sampled schools is not in a sequence, and hence it is difficult to manage the data collection process. For our ease and practical purposes, we have

coded sampled schools and given a separate variable name "VP SEQ CODE" in the list and given a number from 001 to 270.

2. We are also sharing a list of replacement schools for Delhi, Rajasthan, Odisha, and Maharashtra (barring Parbhani Dist) -please see the second sheet. Replacement schools for some sampled schools are not available in the selected block of Puducherry, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, and Parbhani district. The coordinators of Puducherry and A&N need to discuss with state nodal officers - if there is a need for replacement schools and let us know. We will provide them with the list of replacement schools after a discussion with MoE.

3. When and who can replace the sampled school:

The RIE coordinator will share a list of sampled schools with the district or block authority or nodal officer from the state to check the following conditions:

- The sampled school is functional.
- Enrolment is 6 or more in the current academic year.
- The school is accessible, and there is no roadblock due to extreme natural climate conditions.

If a school is permanently closed or enrolment is less than 6 in the current academic year, or the school is not accessible due to extreme climate conditions like- floods, roadblocks, etc., then the RIE coordinator can replace the sampled school and will keep a record of this change. Other than the RIE coordinator, no one will replace the sampled school.

4. Process of replacement school:

"VP SEQ CODE" is given in the list of sampled and replacement schools. For example, the District Education Officer informed that sampled school "xyz" given at the VP SEQ CODE 112 is permanently closed. The RIE coordinator will look at the list of replacement schools and will find out which school is available at VP SEQ CODE 112 in the list.

5. What will happen if data is collected from school which is not included in the sampled list or not replaced by the RIE coordinator

Such a type of school will not be included in the data analysis process.

Data Collection

Capacity Building and conduct of Field Visit

1. One Capacity Building Programme for all the Nodal Officers from the States and UTs and for all the Coordinators and FIs will be done by the Study -Team explaining objectives of the study, modalities and tools and also the conduct of field visits.

Further capacity-building programmes on tools and modalities of field visits will be conducted by the State-study groups.

2. All the State/UT Study Groups are expected to create a whatsapp group of State or UT adding all the members, whose names are included in the state-wise list of members (Annexure-I).

2. Team-lead (Prof. Sridhar Srivastav) and both the Programme Coordinators of Study-Team from NCERT and MoE (Prof. Ranjana Arora and Dr. Reetu Chandra) need to be added in each of these groups so that they will be aware of the progress. Moreover, updated information will also be given to the Advisory Committee Members in a timely manner for planning their visits to any/all these states or UTs by the programme coordinators.

3. Translation of tools in Hindi, Marathi, Odiya, Tamil, Telugu and Malyalam will be coordinated by the concerned Coordinators from RIEs. Multiple copies of the set of tools in translated version will be prepared by the RIE coordinators. However, a kit of items (shapes, story cards, etc.) to be used while implementing Learners' School Preparation Assessment Tool and also English version of the tools will be provided by DCS&D.

4. After collecting a set of tools in the required language version and kit items, tool packets will be prepared by the coordinators for their distribution among FIs. This will be done by the coordinators selecting appropriate location- in the case of Odisha, Rajasthan, Maharashtra and Puducherry, this will be concerned RIE. In case of A&N, it will be SIE and in case of Delhi, it will be DCS&D.

5. The mechanism for distribution of tools among PFIs and FIs will be developed by each of the study-groups as per the context and situation in the state or UT discussing with the nominated nodal officers.
