

Cross Disability Hands on Training for SETs

The idea behind developing the Cross disability Training program is to provide Hands-on Cross disability Training to Special Education Teachers (SETs) who are specialized in specific disability areas such as Hearing Impairment, Visual Impairment, Intellectual Disability/ Mental Retardation and Specific Learning Disability. For instance, SETs who have Visual Impairment Specialization will receive training in Hearing Impairment, Intellectual Disability/ Mental Retardation and Specific Learning Disability areas and vice-versa. This hands-on training is being imparted in the group of 30 SETs for 5 days in each disability area. Primarily it focuses on the development and implementation of Individualized Education Programme (IEP) and teaching strategies. The major method of teaching are activity based teaching, demonstration and hands-on interaction. It also assures that the SET get training in all the other three disability other than his/her specialization. Training is organized as per the approved norms and guidelines of CRE, Rehabilitation council of India (RCI), GOI and all the expenses incurred by SCERT, New Delhi.
