


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



Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan , 2002- flagship

Centrally Sponsored Scheme in partnership with State Governments for UEE across the country.

Right To Education Act, 2009 - provided legal mandate to ensure free & compulsory education to all children in the age group of 6 to 14 years of age.

Challenges


- Parallel institutional arrangements at national, state, district & sub-district levels with little convergence with mainstream school education administration have been created for the planning & management of these CSS.

Solution

- *increased convergence & integration between the Schemes through a single school education development programme covering grades 1-XII*

Vision of Samagra Shiksha

- to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education from pre-school to senior secondary stage in accordance with the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 4 for Education(2015)

Sustainable Development Goal

- **SDG-4.1** - “By 2030, ensure that all boys & girls complete free, equitable & quality primary & secondary education leading to relevant and effective learning outcomes”.
- **SDG 4.5** - “By 2030, eliminate gender disparities in education & ensure equal access to all levels of Education & vocational training for the vulnerable, including persons with disabilities, indigenous people & children in vulnerable situations”.

Major objectives of SS

- provision of quality education
- enhancing learning outcomes in students
- Bridging Social and Gender Gaps in School Education
- Ensuring equity and inclusion at all levels of school education

Major objectives of SS

- Ensuring minimum standards in schooling provisions
- Promoting Vocationalization of education
- Support States in implementation of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009
- Strengthening & up-gradation of SCERTs/ DIETs as nodal agencies for teacher training

Guiding Principles of SS

- **Holistic view of education**, as interpreted in the National Curriculum Framework 2005, with implications for a systemic revamp of the entire content and process of education with significant implications for curriculum, teacher education, educational planning & management

Guiding Principles of SS

- **Equity**, to mean not only equal opportunity, but also creation of conditions in which the disadvantaged sections of the society – children of SC, ST, Muslim minority, landless agricultural workers & children with special needs, etc. – can avail of the opportunity

Guiding Principles of SS

- **Access**, not to be confined to ensuring that a school becomes accessible to all children within specified distance but implies an understanding of the educational needs and predicament of the traditionally excluded categories – the SC, ST and others sections of the most disadvantaged groups, the Muslim minority, girls in general, and children with special needs

Guiding Principles of SS

- **Gender concern**, implying not only an effort to enable girls to keep pace with boys but to view education in the perspective spelt out in the National Policy on Education 1986 /92; i.e. a decisive intervention to bring about a basic change in the status of women

Guiding Principles of SS

- **Centrality of teacher**, to motivate them to innovate and create a culture in the classroom, and beyond the classroom, that might produce an inclusive environment for children, especially for girls from oppressed and marginalized backgrounds

Guiding Principles of SS

- **Moral compulsion** is imposed through the RTE Act on parents, teachers, educational administrators and other stakeholders, rather than shifting emphasis on punitive processes

Guiding Principles of SS

- **Convergent and integrated system of educational management** is pre-requisite for implementation of the RTE law. All states must move in that direction as speedily as feasible.
