CIRCULAR

Subject: Setting of "Bartan Bhandar" in schools and implementation of IEC plan on Plastic Waste Management and Single Use Plastic.

In reference to the review meeting conducted on 04.05.2022 and minutes of the meeting held on 12.04.2022 under Chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary (Environment & Forest) regarding "Phasing out Single Use Plastic". In the aforesaid meeting, the following decision were taken for the first phase and second phase activity to be conducted during 22nd April 2022 to 30th June 2022 and 1st July onwards respectively:

- 1- Setting of Bartan Bhandar in Schools
- 2- Implementation of IEC plan on Plastic Waste Management and Single Use plastic.

The details of the ativities are as under:

- A- Setting of Bartan Bhandar in Schools: "Bartan Bhandars" in schools is to be set-up in all Govt./Govt. Aided/Pvt. Unaided recognized schools of DoE, GNCT of Delhi under the first phase activities for "Phasing out Single-Use Plastic in Delhi". For this, HoSs of all the schools under DoE, GNCT of Delhi need to replace dishes made of plastic materials with the 'Bartan' made of steels, glass, etc. and to keep the 'Bartan' in a separate Store/Almirah/Room which will be named as "Bartan Bhandar". The items from the "Bartan Bhandar" shall be utilized instead of plastic dishes for daily use and all functions in the schools. (Suggested alternatives to Single Use Plastic items is enclosed.)
- B- Implementation of IEC plan on Plastic Waste Management and Single Use plastic: IEC plan on Plastic Waste Management and Single Use Plastics provided by the Department of Environment, Govt. of NCT of Delhi is to be implemented in all the schools of DoE, GNCT of Delhi (Details of IEC plan are mentioned at Annexure- I).

The HoSs of all the Govt./Govt. Aided/Pvt. Unaided Recognized schools under DoE, GNCT of Delhi will submit the action taken report in **Format-I** (Attached) along with selected photographs to their respective DDEs(District) as per the given time-schedule in the attached IEC plan.

All the DDEs(District) will provide the compiled report in r/o the setting of 'Bartan Bhandar' in the schools of their District in **Format-III** and submit to the Science Branch at Mail-Id <u>posup.sciencebranch@gmail.com</u> till 25th May 2022 as well as submit the monthly ATR in **Format-II** as per given time schedule provided in the IEC plan.

(Note: All Exercises and materials that are utilized while performing exercises should not contain plastic).
