// CIRCULAR //

Sub: Common Admission Test (CAT) for Non-Plan Admission in Classes X & XII in Govt. Schools for Academic Session 2022-23

In continuation of the circular No. DE.23(363)/Sch. Br./2022/401 dated 20/04/2022 of School Branch, all the Heads of Govt. Schools are hereby informed that Centralized Common Admission Test (CAT) is scheduled to be held on 11th May 2022 from 10:00 am to 12:00 noon for both the classes X & XII for Non Plan Admissions at district level. Following directions are to be complied with for smooth conduct of test and to ensure that no candidate faces any problem at the time of registration/test.

- One set of Question Paper Booklet of class X and One set of Question Paper Booklet (Stream wise) of class XII will be provided by Examination Branch (HQ) to the DDE (District) for photocopying/ printing.
- 2. Nodal Center In-charges will be deputed by the DDE (District) at their own level.
- DDE (District) should ensure that Question Paper Booklets should be photocopied or printed as per number of the candidates registered for CAT 2022-23.
- 4. Question Paper Booklets will be stored under the lock and key and the room will be sealed and must be under surveillance.
- 5. Sealed packets of the Question Paper Booklets will be handed over to the Nodal Center Incharges on the day of the test.
- It will be the sole responsibility of Nodal Center In-charges to conduct the test under strict observation and submit the sealed packet of Question Paper Booklets (Answer Sheets) within one hour of completion of the test to DDE (District) for evaluation.
- 7. Evaluation will be done under the strict observation of DDE (District).
- 8. Result will be declared on 13th May, 2022 and displayed in the office of DDE (District).
- 9. DDE District and DDE Zone to ensure safe custody, storage, smooth distribution and smooth conduct of the Common Admission Test.
- 10. Common Admission Test for Class X:
 - (a) Question Paper Booklet will consist 96 questions of 100 marks in five subjects: Hindi (20 Marks), English (20 Marks), Maths (20 Marks), Science (20 Marks) and Social Science (20 Marks).
 - (b) Total weightage of Question Paper will be of 100 marks.

11. Common Admission Test for Class XII:

- (a) Each subject will consist 25 questions except of English.
- (b) Total weightage of Question Paper will be as per the total subjects of a stream.
- (c) Common Admission Test will be conducted stream wise in the following subjects:
 - For Commerce Stream: English (25 marks), Maths (25 marks), Accountancy (25 marks) & Economics (25 marks).

Note: For Commerce without Maths, Maths will not be considered.

ii. For Science Stream: English (25 marks), Maths (25 marks), Physics (25 marks), Chemistry (25 marks) & Biology (25 marks)

Note: For Science with Maths, Maths will be considered. For Science with Biology, Biology will be considered.

iii. For Humanities Stream: English (25 marks), Hindi (25 marks), Pol. Science (25 marks), Economics (25 marks), History (25 marks) & Geography (25 marks)

Note: It is mandatory to attempt any one language along with other three elective subjects. Maximum Four Subjects are to be attempted for the eligibility of the admission for classes XII.

12. Candidate will be declared "Pass" in Common Admission Test only if he/she secures minimum 33% marks in each of the subjects separately as well as in aggregate.

Heads of Schools are directed to disseminate this information to all the candidates and their parents at the time of submission of the filled application forms.
