**CIRCULAR**

**Subject: Exhibition-cum-Competition of Teaching Learning Materials (TLMs) for Pre-Primary and Primary classes for the session 2024-25.**

Teaching Learning Materials are used by facilitators to help students to understand a lesson quickly, effectively and practically. TLMs provide a range of learning experiences to learners. The most effective method to learn is involving direct and concrete learning experience.

Additionally, National Curriculum Framework emphasizes on the essentiality of varieties of TLM (ref. para 5.4) and New Education Policy insisted on sharing best practices and working collaboratively to ensure that all children are learning. (ref. para 5.10)

Preserving the outlook envisioned by NCF and NEP, Teaching Learning Material Exhibition at School, Zonal and District Level was announced in Annual School Calendar 2024-25. To foster a sense of competitiveness and to enhance innovation and creativity, these exhibitions will also have a competition track. This track aims to showcase the innovative and effective TLMs created by the Assistant Teachers of the DoE.

As per schedule given in the annual school calendar, it is expected that TLM exhibition at school level would have been organised.

The schedule of the programme is as follows:

| S. No. | Exhibition-cum-competition Level | Participants/ Entries   | Time Period                          |
|--------|----------------------------------|-------------------------|--------------------------------------|
| 1      | Zonal Level                      | Best 5 from each school | 2 <sup>nd</sup> week of August, 2024 |
| 2      | District Level                   | Best 25 from each Zone  | 3 <sup>rd</sup> week of August, 2024 |

## **General Guidelines for the participants/ organisers:**

### **a) Zonal Level**

- 5 best TLMs from each Sarvodaya Vidyalayas and SoEs having Primary classes shall be submitted for Zonal Level TLM exhibition. Participation of each school is mandatory.
- Each DDE Zone shall organise the exhibition at zonal Level with the help of venue in-charge & respective Hub Synergizers **by the end of the second week of August, 2024.**
- After the exhibition, the best entries are to be selected by team/committee constituted by the concerned DDE Zone for the participation in the district level competition.
- Best 25 TLMs from each zone shall be sent for District Level Competition-cum-Exhibition.

### **b) District Level**

- Each DDE District will organise the exhibition at district Level with the help of venue in-charge & respective District Synergizer **by the end of the third week of August, 2024.**
- After the exhibition, the best entries are to be selected by team/committee constituted by the concerned DDE District for the participation in the state level competition.
- Art and Craft work created and developed by the students of Primary Section will also be a part of the district level exhibition.
- Best 15 TLMs from each district shall be sent for State Level Competition-cum-Exhibition.
- Exhibition at district level should be in display for at least 2 days. DDE district shall ensure that all the Assistant Teachers of their respective district visit the exhibition and get familiarized with all the TLMs.
- Teachers posted in evening shift schools may be directed to visit the exhibition in morning and vice-versa in such a way that it doesn't hamper teaching hours.

### **c) State Level**

Schedule of the State Level Competition-cum-Exhibition will be announced in due course.

### Selection Criteria

A panel/ committee of 3 members may be constituted as the judge for the competition at different level by each organiser. The rubrics for the judgement are as follows:

| S. No. | Parameter                 | Marks |
|--------|---------------------------|-------|
| 1      | Eco-friendly              | 10    |
| 2      | Economically viable       | 10    |
| 3      | Pedagogical Effectiveness | 10    |
| 4      | Child Centred             | 10    |
| 5      | Overall Presentation      | 10    |

All the organisers are directed to comply the same and organise Competition-cum-Exhibition effectively at their ends. The Heads of all Sarvodaya Vidyalayas must ensure the availability of all required materials to the teachers.


