CIRCULAR

Sub: Composite School Grant under Samagra Shiksha for Remaining 468 Elementary schools and 1071 Secondary Schools for the year 2023-2024.

The Project Approval Board (PAB) 2023-2024 of Samagra Shiksha (SS), MOE has approved a sum of Rs. 2098.9 Lac as Composite School Grant for 2714 Govt. Schools (DOE, MCD, NDMC, DCB, DSW) for the year 2023-2024 as per U- DISE data for the year 2021-2022 out of which Rs.909.9 Lac as Composite School Grant for selected 1175 Elementary Govt. Schools (DOE, MCD, NDMC, DCB, DSW) was released and the remaining Rs.1187.25 Lac is being released for remaining 468 Elementary Schools and 1071 Secondary schools.

Guidelines regarding utilization of Composite School Grant under Samagra Shiksha for the year 2023-24

As a support for quality improvement, Composite school grant is being sanctioned on an annual basis to Government Schools (under the management of DoE, MCDs, DCB, NDMC & DSW) under the Samagra Shiksha. The objective is to utilize this additional support to create conducive learning environment in schools. It is desired that this grant should be judiciously spent on various quality interventions aimed at the all-round development of the students. The Heads of Schools, in consultation with the SMCs and the Students Council may utilize this grant in their endeavour to provide a conducive environment in the school for effective Teaching Learning Process.

In this regard, HoSs/Members of SMCs/District DDEs/DPOs, DURCCs, CRCCs and AOs/AAOs concerned are requested to note the following guidelines for strict compliance:

- 1. Composite School Grant under Samagra Shiksha is directly authorised to district account through PFMS portal by SS-HQ. The districts shall further set limits for the school for expenditure which is to be incurred in consultation with SMCs and the Student Council.
- 2. The HoS shall utilize the Grant under Samagra Shiksha as per approved norms. There is NO REQUIREMENT of taking any Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction from the DPO/District DDE for incurring expenditure out of Composite School Grant.
- 3. Proper Account is to be maintained by each school of the Grant received under Samagra Shiksha. Account so maintained at the level of the School is auditable and may be examined any time by the Central Team of MoE/ Team constituted at State Level/SS HQ/Team of Directorate of Education, Delhi.
- **4.** Utilization Certificate, duly signed by the Head of the School, is to be submitted by each HoS to the concerned DPO by 31s March, 2024 positively who, in turn, shall submit the same to the SS-HQ by 1st April, 2024.
- **5.** All the HoS concerned shall follow the GFR-2017 for the expenditure norms for proper & judicious utilization of the grant. As far as possible, all procurement Page 4 of 7

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should be effected through GEM(Govt. E-market) and payments should be made through E-payment system in respect of vendor/supplier (Cashless).

Given below are various suggestive items on which this grant can be utilized along with the reasonable maximum amount (i.e. Spending Limit) that can be spent on each such item(s). Simultaneously, it is to be ensured by the Head of the School that, as far as possible, expenditure out of "Composite School Grant" under Samagra Shiksha is made only on those items which directly facilitate better learning of students and for which funds are not available from Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

Guidelines for the Composite School Grant for the Year 2023-24

1. Repair/replacement of defective/ obsolete / unserviceable equipment in the school. 2. Other recurring costs such as consumables, Play material newspapers, electricity charges, internet charges, water charges, teaching aids etc. Purchase of First Aid Boxes including first aid material. 3. Annual maintenance and repair of existing school building, toilets and other facilities to ensure maintenance of the infrastructure in good condition. Wall painting on school boundary walls. 4. At least 10 % of the Composite School Grant is to be mandatorily spent on Activities related to Swachhta Action Plan. 5. Schools are allowed to purchase Book Shelves but purchase of furniture including Almirah is not Allowed. 6. Organisation of Intra-class/Inter-Class Quiz/ Debate/Elocution/Poetry Recitation/Drawing competitions etc. 7. Organisation of online/ offline workshops for children on Origami/Macramé//Quelling/Pottery/ Paper Mache/Book Binding/ Puppet making etc along with purchase of material for practice by children 8. Organization of Co-curricular activities such as Legal Literacy, Gender Sensitization, Health Awareness Programme on Hygiene and Sanitation, Safe & unsafe Touch, Substance Abuse etc as announced from time to time as well as Celebration of important occasions like Independence Day, Republic Day, Martyr's Day, Vijay Divas, Children's Day, Science Day, Women's Day Yoga Day, Communal Harmony Week etc. 9. Organization of Music/Dance/Theatre activities at the school level (Hiring of dresses/costumes/musical instruments). 10. Purchase and Repair of Musical Instruments 11.
