CIRCULAR

Subject: Organising a State Level Quiz Competition for the students of Primary Classes (Classes III to V) of Sarvodaya Vidyalayas.

Nursery Primary Branch, DoE is committed to creating an instrumental environment for the students of primary that supports learning culture, addresses a learner's needs & encourage the students' involvement in various activities. To achieve this goal, Nursery Primary Branch has been organising many State Level initiatives like Chess League, TLM Exhibition-cum-Competition, Handwriting & Dictation Competition etc on regular basis. This Branch also provides a platform to the students of primary classes in the state level cultural events to showcase their skills & talent regularly.

These kinds of initiatives not only help to bolster the confidence of the students but also provide a chance to the Assistant teachers to celebrate the efforts they put in the primary classes with the students.

In continuation of these initiatives, it is now decided, with the approval of the Director, Education, to organise the 'State Level Quiz Competition' for the students of Primary Classes (Classes III to V) enrolled in the Sarvodaya Vidyalayas. Participating in a Quiz Competition offers several benefits, like

1. Increased knowledge and awareness,
2. Enhanced memory and retention skills,
3. Improved critical thinking and problem-solving skills,
4. Boost in confidence,
5. Improved communication & reading skills,
6. Exposure to different perspectives and ideas; &
7. Motivation for learning.

In a nutshell, these benefits contribute to the overall academic and personal development of the students. The said competition will be organized in the following manner:

Sr. No.	Level	Organiser	Schedule	No. of best entries to be sent on next level
1	School Level	Schools Concerned	16 th to 18 th November, 2023	Top 3 position holders from each class will qualify for the zonal level competition.
2	Zonal Level	DDE (Zone)	Up to 8 th December, 2023	Top 20 % position holders from each class group will qualify for the district level competition.
3	District level	DDE (District)	Up to 16 th December, 2023	Top 20% position holders from each class group will qualify for the state level competition.
4	State Level	Nursery Primary Branch	Up to 23 th December, 2023	Prizes will be distributed to the Top 10 Position Holder in each class. Appreciation-cum-Participation certificates for all Participants.

➤ **General Guidelines for the Quiz Competition:**

- There will be two rounds for each grade (III to V) at each level.
 - Preliminary Round – Pen Paper Test Quiz.
 - Final Round – Verbal questionnaire.
- All rounds will be conducted through a quiz in MCQ pattern.
- All the questions will be bilingual in nature.
- There will be no negative marking.
- Each Organiser will select its own team for preparing the questionnaire for the Quiz.
- At each level, every participant will get maximum 10 seconds to answer the question (In Verbal questionnaire Round). If he/she fails to do so, the question will be passed to the next participant. Multiple groups may be formed for the Verbal questionnaire according to the No. of questions to be asked at each level.
- At School & Zonal Level competition, the merit will be prepared according to the result of Verbal questionnaire round only.
- At District & State Level competition, the merit will be prepared by combining the marks of both rounds.
