Subject: State Level Art Exhibition cum Competition for the students of primary classes for the session 2023-24.

The Nursery Primary Branch has been continuously working in bringing the qualitative improvement in primary education. For this, a lot of initiatives have been introduced so far that have brought a major change in the confidence level of the students. It is seen that the students perform better if their creations are noticed. Appreciation is indeed a powerful motivator for the students. When students receive praise and recognition for their efforts and achievements, it boosts their self-system.

In this connection, an art exhibition cum competition, featuring paintings by primary students, can be a wonderful and creative event. It can be a great way to showcase young talent and encourage their artistic expression. Exhibiting paintings created by primary students can have numerous benefits, including:

- 1. Self-Expression: Art exhibitions allow young students to express themselves creatively and share their unique perspectives, thoughts, and emotions through their artwork.
- 2. Boosts Confidence: The recognition and praise received for their artwork can boost a child's self-esteem and self-confidence, encouraging them to explore their artistic abilities further.
- 3. Sense of Accomplishment: Participating in an exhibition gives students a sense of accomplishment as they see their hard work on display for others to appreciate.
- **4.** Communication Skills: Students often need to discuss and describe their artwork to visitors, which helps develop their verbal communication skills and ability to articulate their thoughts and ideas.
- **5.** Cultural Appreciation: Art can provide a window into different cultures and traditions, fostering an appreciation for diversity and cultural understanding.

- **6.** Creativity and Imagination: Art exhibitions inspire and nurture creativity and imagination in students, encouraging them to think outside the box and experiment with various artistic techniques.
- 7. Inspiration: Viewing the work of peers and more advanced artists can be inspiring for young students, encouraging them to continue exploring their artistic talents.

In the light of the above, sensing the benefits of the exhibition amongst the primary students, the Competent Authority has decided to organize a **State Level Art Exhibition cum Competition for the students of primary classes** in the first week on November 2023 tentatively.

General Guidelines for the schools:

- 1. The schools will provide complete guidance and ample opportunity for practice to all the students of primary classes for better participation in the school level painting/ drawing competition. The students may be encouraged to continue their practice during the Autumn Break at home as well.
- 2. The participation of the students must be restricted for primary classes only.
- 3. Any medium (sketch pen, oil pastels, water colour, mix media etc.) can be used.
- 4. Neither the initials nor the name of the students should be there on the painting/ drawing.
- 5. No details of the school should be there on the painting/drawing.
- 6. The schools will organize a school level painting/ drawing competition for primary classes by 30th October 2023 and select two best entries. A certificate regarding completion of the competition and selection thereafter, should be taken from the Primary Incharge of the school on the letter head and the same should be forwarded by the HoS (with stamp) to Nursery Primary Branch during submission.
- 7. The schools will submit the selected two best entries (with covering letter & Certificate) to Nursery Primary Branch on 31st October, 2023 at the Conference Hall (HQ) as per the schedule given below:
