CIRCULAR

Subject: Book Review Writing Facility for students of Govt. Schools of Directorate of Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

Directorate of Education is initiating a Book Review Writing Facility (BRWF) for its students in the Govt. schools. The primary objective of this initiative is to foster a love for reading and appreciation, encouraging literary exploration, enhancing the reading experiences among students and supporting their academic growth. This facility will provide students an opportunity to share their insights and reflections after reading books from the extensive collection of their school library.

Objectives:

1. **To foster a love for reading:** Active involvement of students in reviewing books will promote a connection with reading, encouraging them to explore diverse genres, authors, publications and expanding their interests.
2. **To develop analytical and writing skills:** Crafting the book review involving in organizing thoughts cohesively and structuring them into a written piece will help students in developing their analytical and writing skills, benefitting them in their academic and professional tasks.
3. **To encourage self-awareness:** Writing of book review will reflect on what the students have read and it will encourage them to be introspective as well. Book Review Writing Facility will convey to students that their perspectives are valued.
4. **Experience sharing and Recommendation:** Through writing book reviews, students will be sharing their experiences of reading the books which will guide their peer students seeking recommendations, selecting the books that might align with their interests.

Methodology:

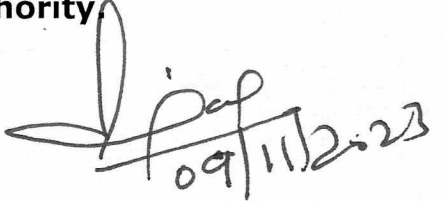
1. A dedicated corner with a separate register in school library should be designated for Book Review Writing Facility by the students.
2. Students should be motivated to write the reviews of books they read from the collection of their school library.
3. Students shall have the freedom for writing book reviews of books of their choice.
4. Students may be recommended books for writing reviews.

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5. After reading a book, students should be encouraged to write reviews that encapsulate their thoughts and overall impressions of the book.
6. Students shall have the choice to write their book reviews in pictorial or drawing form.
7. The book reviews written by the students shall be displayed in school library and during the assembly time, to be read by all the students and get motivated and encouraged to engage more with the school library collection and inculcate reading habit among them.
8. Each Govt. school shall submit the best 02 book reviews written by students, every month at edu.bookreviewwritingfacility@gmail.com.

In addition to the Book Review Writing Facility (BRWF), when new arrivals of resources reach in the school library, a segment promoting these resources during the assembly time will be an excellent help of students knowing about these latest additions to their school library. Highlighting the new arrivals, school librarian/ teachers may reinforce the importance of reading using the library as a valuable resource for learning and enjoyment.
