Sub: Celebration of Har Ghar Tiranga 2025- Reg.

Heads of all Govt., Govt. Aided and Unaided Recognized Private Schools of Directorate of Education (DoE), GNCTD are hereby directed to organize activities as per the schedule as under:

S. No.	Date	Activities to be Undertaken
1	05.08.2025	Make and wear Tiranga brooches
2	06.08.2025	Decorating school walls and boards with Tiranga- inspired art
3	07.08.2025	Organizing Tiranga Rangoli competitions across schools.
4	08.08.2025	Organizing Tiranga Rakhi-making workshops and competitions in coordination with the Department of Posts for facilitating to dispatch the rakhis to soldiers and police personnel.
5	11.08.2025	Organize letter writing drives by students addressed to armed forces and police personnel in coordination with the Departmen of Posts for facilitating to dispatch the letters to soldiers and police personnel.
6	12.08.2025	Encouraging students to participate in National quiz on the Tiranga via the MyGov platform in coordination with Meit (MyGov).
7	13.08.2025	Display of exhibitions provided by Ministry of Culture (available in download section of website www.harghartiranga.com) is educational institutions.

Letter writing Drive should be organized on 11th August, 2025 wherein students will write letters addressed to Armed Forces and Police Personnel. Schools shall coordinate with the Department of Posts for facilitating to dispatch the letters to nearby Police Stations or Army HQ/ Station. Students may refer to the following suggestive guidelines for writing letters:

- Appreciation for their sacrifices in working tirelessly, even during festivals and holidays.
