**Subject: Suggestive Activities for the students of primary classes during Summer Vacation.**

Further, the students should be encouraged by the concerned teachers to seek assistance from their family members and complete their activities/ project work during the summer vacation. It will also encourage participation of family in the student's learning journey.

**Suggestive activities for summer vacation**

Nursery & KG

- Draw pictures of foods that you enjoyed eating during vacation.
- Learn to brush your teeth daily independently.
- Make a video of yourself playing games like pithoo, stapoo etc.
- Learn to greet people around you with a smile like Namaste, Good Morning or in your native language.
- Ask your family members to tell you a story/poem and you may share it with your friends after vacation.

Class 1

- Learn any one poem from the book. Be ready to recite it with actions in class.
- Make a family tree.
- Name of 10 objects related to daily life such as fruits, vegetables, colours,
- Draw and color geometric shapes.
- Learn the name of all foods that you are eating during vacation.
- Learn to brush your teeth daily independently.

Class 2

- Pick a story and write a new/funny ending (6–8 lines).
- Practice of Handwriting in Hindi and English language.
- Make a poster based on any one season and the clothes you wear in that season.
- Count objects at home (spoons, books, toys) and write their names with numbers.
- Learn to make a simple dish/drink (like lemon Shikanji or fruit salad).
- Make a paper fan or a greeting card for your friend.

Class 3

- Draw a comic strip having 4 boxes and create your own story with small sentences.
- Practice of Dictation and Handwriting in Hindi & English languages
- Make a paper rangoli using paper cut-out shapes like circle, triangle, square , rectangle of different colors.
- Make a poster of your favorite Yoga Pose.
- List out important monuments/ buildings/ places of Delhi.



- Note ten (10) one liner News/ Current affairs related to sports in the month of June.
- Learn a patriotic song of your choice.

#### Class 4

- Ask any family member 3 questions (example: What do you like to do?). Write their answers. (either Hindi or English)
- Make Dictionaries of 50 words each for both Hindi & English language.
- Make a poster on any one Sport that you like.
- Locate states and union territories on the map of India with their capitals.
- Note twenty (20) one liner News/current affairs related to sports.
- Prepare a one minute dance in your favorite dance form or a patriotic song. (you can perform it in the class later)

#### Class 5

- Write a small essay on what movie/show/cartoon film you watched and what you liked or disliked about it in 10-15 sentences.
- Make lists of Synonyms and Antonyms of at least 50 words each for both Hindi and English language.
- Make a sketch/ painting/ drawing/ poster based on current topic like environmental issues.
- Locate all the continents and oceans on a world map.
- Note the daily temperature and make a weather report for the month of June (you can use smart chart to present the data).
- Create twenty (20) word problems based on day-to-day life and covering all basic mathematical operations (Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division).
- Learn a role play of one minute for any one character of your choice from your favorite movie/cartoon.
