Anne Frank was a German-born, Jewish girl. The diary entry records two years of Anne's life from 12 June 1943 to 1 August 1945. She wrote while in hiding with her family. She writes clearly about the persecutions laid down on Jews by the Nazis. She wrote that Jews were forbidden to drive, to visit public places and they were forced to wear a Yellow Star to identify themselves. The Ruler of Nazi's and the harsh face of German government was illustrated in her diary by writing that Gestapo loaded all the Jewish people in cattle trucks and send them to concentration camps. The Jews were killed in the concentration camps.

Anne Frank wrote about the political situations of second world war. The invasion by America and England and other events. As, her life was changed in hiding period, she wrote about feelings of ~~for~~ the people around her, like her feelings about her mother, her sister Margot Frank, her father and many others. She wrote her diary in a variety of moods. She wrote about the daily routines, items available for food to the families in hiding. In the last part of her diary she wrote about her two sides. She called herself "a bundle of nerves". She wrote her anger, confusions, hopes, feelings, the political situations, situation of the war and even about the reviews of people about the war, the horror of the war, the holocaust. All these objects made the theme of the "Diary of a Young Girl". Moreover, Anne's feelings and
