First we went to see the animals with sharp teeth. There were lions, tigers and even bears.




After that we went to the bird house. There were birds of all sizes and colours. They were all very loud.

LOST IN THE SEA


My name is Sana. I am a fish. I live in the sea with my family. The sea is very big.


I followed the boat away from the beach. I swam and swam, the boat was very fast. After a long time, I looked down. I was swimming above my home town!



Water is essential for our survival. In fact, a person can survive for 8 weeks without food but without water, he or she will not be able to survive for more than 5 days. Water is not only important for the human body, it also plays a huge role in our daily lives. We use water for drinking, cleaning our homes, growing plants, etc. Let us read the inspiring story of Dr. Rajendra Singh who is known for his efforts to conserve water.

In the 1980s in Rajasthan, Rajendra

Singh watched as people left his district to go live in other areas. The villagers had to leave their homes because the Arvari River was drying up.



Rajendra Singh decided to help the villagers by bringing the water back to their villages. He built rainwater storage tanks, called *johads*. He built *johads* on


the streams that flowed into the river. The johads increased the water in the river by collecting



rainwater. He also built 'check dams' on the downward flowing streams.

At first, Rajendra's plans did not work. But he kept trying, and eventually he succeeded in bringing the Arvari River back to life.

In 1975, he founded an NGO called 'Tarun Bharat Sangh' for water management. He is known as the 'Waterman of India' today.







Cricket is a bat and ball game. It is played between two teams of eleven players each. Let us read more about this game.







What is a bullock cart? I have never seen it anywhere!

A bullock cart is a type of small, open vehicle. It has four or two wheels.





How is a bullock cart different from a car?

A bullock cart is mostly made of wood. A car has a steering wheel, an accelerator, brakes and an engine. These are made of metal.





Can a bullock cart run as fast as a car?

A car has an engine so it can move very fast. The engine needs petrol or diesel to work. A bullock cart is pulled by one or more bullocks so it can only go as fast as the bullocks can walk.





Do people still use bullock carts today?

Yes, bullock carts are still used in many parts of the world. Bullock carts are mostly used in villages and small towns to carry things or people from one place to another.



In the early days, pigeons were often used to send messages from one person to another. Messages were written on a

piece of paper and the paper would be tied to the pigeon's leg. The pigeon would then fly to receiver of the message.



Due to the long distances that pigeons would travel, this method took a lot of time to send and receive messages.

With the arrival of postal services, communication became a lot easier and faster than before. People started using postcards and letters to send messages to each other. A postman delivered postcards and letters to people.

ARUNIMA SINHA



Do you know who an amputee is? An amputee is a person who has lost their arm, leg or hand because of an injury or illness. Let us read about Arunima Sinha - the first female amputee to climb Mount Everest.

Arunima Sinha was born on July 20, 1988 in Ambedkar Nagar in Uttar Pradesh. She was a national level volleyball player.

In 2011, she lost a leg in a train accident. After the accident, Arunima became an amputee. Rather than feeling sad about it, she wanted to challenge herself.

Arunima decided to climb Mount Everest. Mount Everest is in Nepal and it is the highest mountain peak in the world.

When Arunima left the hospital, she joined a mountaineering course at Nehru Institute of Mountaineering in Uttarkashi. Her performance at the institute was great. Her family members encouraged her to climb Mount Everest. She contacted Bachendri Pal, the first Indian woman to climb Mount Everest.

Bachendri Pal agreed to train Arunima.

Arunima trained very hard. She climbed many mountains on different continents in 2012.






On May 21, 2013, she became the first female amputee to climb Mount Everest.

Arunima was later honoured by the Uttar Pradesh government for her extraordinary achievement. In 2015, she was awarded Padma Shri, the fourth highest civilian award of India. Arunima made India proud by doing the impossible.

MADHU'S RECIPE











Madhu recently learnt how to make upma from her aunt. Today, she is going to share the recipe with us.

Hello friends! I am Madhu. Today, I will show you how to make *upma*. Let us go to the kitchen.

We will need some water, oil, salt, red chilli powder, mustard seeds, curry leaves, dried red chilli, groundnuts and one cup of rava. We will also need vegetables like onions, carrots, peas, tomatoes and some green chillies. We will also need chopped tomatoes, carrots, onions and chillies.



First roast one cup of rava in a pan until it turns brown. Make sure you keep stirring it so that it does not burn.

Next, heat some oil in a pan. Add mustard seeds, dried red chilli, groundnuts and some curry leaves to it. Then, put all the vegetables and mix them well for 2 minutes. After this, add some salt and red chilli powder according to your taste.

Now, pour two cups of water to the mixture and let it simmer for a while. Add the roasted rava in the boiling water and keep stirring it until the water evaporates and it becomes thick.

Look, Friends! Our *upma* is ready. Once

it cools down a bit, we can serve it with some coconut chutney.
